Alex and Maude
June 17, 1902

This month we introduce the family of Alex and Maude (Richey) English. They were born in 1875 and 1883 respectively, in Franklin Park, of parents who also resided in Franklin Park all their lives.

Alex and Maude were married in 1902, and were blessed with 5 children...Jane (McKinney), Helen (Stevens), Lloyd, Clare, and Reed.

Soon after getting married, the couple bought a farm directly across the road and above the current location of Fairmount Church. The driveway leading to their farm can still be seen when the leaves are off the trees.

The English family worked very hard on the farm, producing vegetables, fruit, eggs, and other farm items which they sold to the mill worker families in Ambridge and other communities along the Ohio River.

Alex and Maude died in 1955 and 1985, and are buried in the Fairmount Church cemetery.

Descendants of Alex and Maude still live in the North Hills area of Pittsburgh.
